Q: Getting the sequence of files to create in R CMD INSTALL or INSTALL2 I'm trying to get the sequence of the files to create using the R CMD INSTALL or the R CMD INSTALL2 command. I've got something working now, but it doesn't quite do what I want. `install.packages(path = ., repos = "")` Now I have the possibility to run it like this: `install.packages("ytdb", repos = "")` But I want to run it like this: `install.packages("ytdb")` In this case, it seems to only install `ytdb-0.4.tar.gz`. What I want is to install all files in the current working directory. A: @James has mentioned a way to add the `--with-data-dir` option to tell `install.packages()` where to install to. The path argument is passed to that option. However, you can also pass a character vector containing a space separated list of paths where to install to. `install.packages("ytdb", dependencies = "all", repos = "", build.depends = "devtools")`
